
Our Vision:

INITIATIVES

AKSHARA was initiated with the vision of building strong foundation of education as well as access to all-inclusive welfare programmes to develop a learning system for these children.

The main objective was the overall development of the children and so educational visits and small Primary School Education trips were also organised to help them for I to VIII grade explore the outside world.

Under this initiative, another programme "nutrition programme" was also introduced wherein we started with the daily provision of nutritious meals to the students.

Under the initiative GYAAN, Samvedana supports private high school education for grade VIII to XII. It also organises various workshops on



various subjects such as computer software, personality grooming, socio-economic development and others that work towards High School Education holistic development of the students. Educational

are also arranged so that the students are able learn via interacting with the outside world. The main operation under this initiative is to assist the students in acquiring admissions in high schools and colleges.

SAKHI provides counselling work that is integral to Samvedana's projects. Counselling is supported by numerous workshops that emphasize on

strengthening their morale, guiding them in the required directions and empowering them with knowledge.

Hence, it joined hands with the government to undertake the social responsibility by running Aanganwadi centres under Integrated

Child Development System (ICDS) project of the GOI. To reinforce this idea, it conducts a variety of workshops and welfare events for adolescent girls, pregnant women and lactating mothers to empower their lives.

MITRA was initiated with a belief that a more sensitized society could be created if the more

fortunate ones had the opportunity to serve to the less privileged. Therefore this initiative provides a platform of exposure to these children through our Happeee Diwali Mela and Happeee Summer Workshops.



These workshops are conducted by volunteers who wish to help and empower these children.

UDGREEV is an initiative originated for imparting vocational skills and special training through experts and attempts to link the creativity of youth



and women with market requirements. It arranges udgreev exhibitions for the adolescent youth and women to help them demonstrate their creativity and talent

making them economically independent. This boosts their confidence and enables a pragmatic understanding of the world.

This initiative of Samvedana, in the rural part of Ahmedabad, contributes in the development of the area by providing quality education to the children,

thereby, shaping their future. It is a primary school built to uplift the rural India with education. Till date we have five registered



English medium schools at Lana-Dholka, Vataman, Badarkha, Matar & Tarapur that runs classes from Playgroup till grade 8.



ACADEMIC TRAINING AND EVALUATION

Samvedana believes in continuous and measured development of children and therefore at all Samvedana centres remedial classes are conducted which includes traditional blackboard teaching as well as use of natural resources, audio visual aids and computer systems leading to enhanced understanding of the subject.

The student to mentor ratio is 1:25 and so, with the help of our volunteers, special attention to weak students is possible. This has led to growth of each and every student which is evident in this year's academic results.



SUPPLEMENTRY EDUCATION ACTIVITIES

Students of HL INSTITUTE OF COMMERCE organised a fair called "Anand Mela " for the kids at samvedana. This fair had different game stalls, dance, art & craft activities, technology based learning activities, through which the students were able to broaden their horizon in various areas.

On 28th November Samvedana alongwith "Deloitte" – Consultancy Firm, celebrated their Impact Day, wherein the employees of the firm spent one full day with Samvedana's children. This event was organized at both the centres of Samvedana – Vadaj centre and Vastrapur centre of Samvedana.

HAPPEEE SUMMER camp is one of the summer camps organized every year by Samvedana during summer vacations. The camp was held at BKMIBA, H.L commerce college campus from 23th April 2014 to 7th May 2014.

A total of 350 students participated in the camp and were divided into three groups according to their ages- Joy, Smile and Giggle. The Samvedana team comprised of almost 50 volunteers and 10 ten teachers working with the kids. The kids were provided with lunch cooked by the volunteers in the campus canteen. A variety of guest faculties were invited to deliver special lectures and various workshops were held also for the volunteers.


